### **Timescale**

### **Finance**

This is also a major concern given the pressures imposed by Covid-19 on all budgets. Hence no definite financing streams can be shown. They will all be dependent on what finance is available when, and from what budget. Individual financing will have to be sought at the time of each project. Grant funding may also be available. Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) money will, where possible, be used to fund the projects listed in this appendix.
