OUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

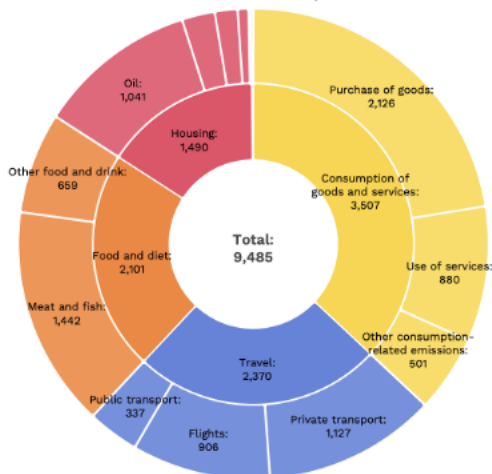
Carbon Footprint is a measure of the amount of carbon dioxide released from all our actions such as eating, shopping, travelling and generally living!

The lower the figure, the better for the environment, with an aim of net zero.

The average per household carbon footprint* for our parish has decreased from 15,255 in 2022 to 9,485 to 2024. Good work!

(measured in tonnes CO₂e²)

- Housing**
Emissions resulting from residents' use of energy in their homes.
- Food and diet**
Emissions resulting from the consumption of food and drink products by residents.
- Travel**
Emissions resulting from the transport choices & behaviours of residents.
- Waste**
Emissions resulting from the management of waste generated by residents.
- Consumption of goods and services**
Emissions resulting from the purchase of goods and the use of services by residents.
