

History Working Party Minutes

Minutes of Meeting on 25th November 2022 at 9.30am in The Pattern Hall, Charlestown.

1. Charlestown Interpretation Board and Walks

Main Board

TR confirmed that the parish council had approved the scheme and would provide financial support. It was felt that as part of an on-going project to place Information Boards around the parish a more "parish council" colour scheme should be used similar to the one used on the Trenarren Board. Copy to be made available to HWP. AT will work with these colours.

The timeline was discussed following TR's suggestion. It was felt that the end of the fishing in 2012/13 had a negative feel. It was also agreed that reference should be made to the importance of filming. AT will work on a revised timeline. The logos for the Parish Council, Charlestown History Group and the WHS should be displayed. TR will send AT the PC logo.

QR Boards

It was decided that the QR boards should contain just the QR code itself and details of the location.

TR will prepare wording for the Cask Banks, Ore Floor, China Clay Dry and Roundhouse.

AT will prepare wording for the Inner Dock (both sides), the Pilchard Cellars, the Outer Harbour and Barkhouse Lane.

Locations were discussed for these boards. AT will send TR the photos of the locations previously discussed.

TR will ask the Clerk to contact, the Harbour, the Gig Club, the Nest and Margaret Nowcombe (Salamander) for their agreement prior to applying for Listed Building Consent.

The exact location for the QR code board at Barkhouse Lane will need to be revisited due to parking issues.

Additional Board

The PC had suggested that an additional (smaller) Information Board should be placed in the Car Park.

TR will ask the Clerk to contact John Kneale.
